

The postmark must be before December 31 for the contribution to be included in 2017. Contributions may also be brought to the church office by 11:00 a.m. Friday, December 29. Please give joyfully in response to God's written Word and the Word that became flesh and dwelt among us!

Lastly, we plan to begin the new year with an emphasis on evangelism and outreach. Everyone is urged to invite others to hear a clear gospel presentation Sunday morning, January 7. I am hoping and praying that over 700 people will hear the gospel and respond positively. Please join me in inviting guests for this day of potential harvest.
