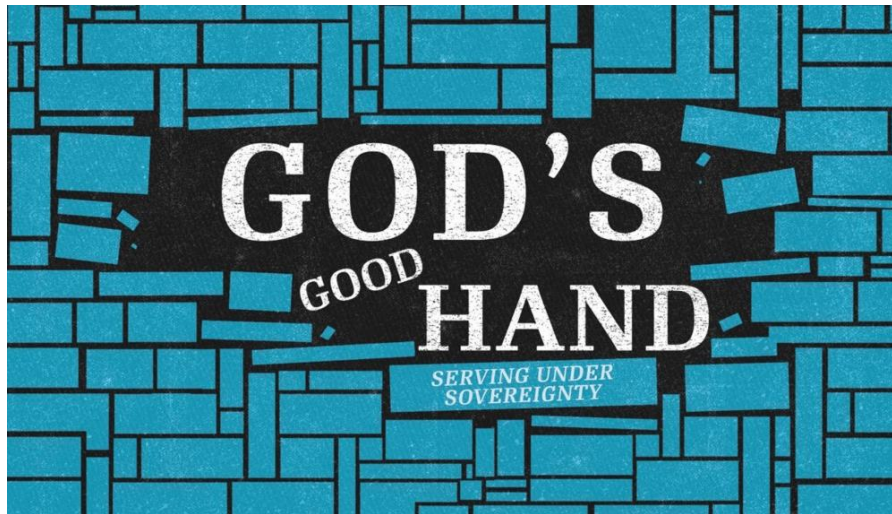

Update on the Building Project: The Building Team plans to make a motion during the Business Meeting on Sunday evening, May 17 for the church to approve the recommended contractor. Based on the \$1.5 million pledged to our two-year capital campaign, further discussion about pressing needs, and comments from contractors during the interview process, the Building Team believes the best plan is to move forward with construction of the children's wing first (Phase 1B) and possibly the common gathering space (Phase 1A), if financially feasible. The team anticipates having a project budget and more specific direction regarding construction matters within the next 4-6 weeks. Construction could begin as early as August or September, pending church approval of the expected debt and the project itself. The team, staff, and Stewardship Committee remain hopeful that the Fruitful Goal of \$2 million pledged will be reached soon. Less than \$500,000 is needed to meet that goal, which could potentially allow for additional building options.

If you would like to submit a pledge card but have not yet done so, please feel free to call the church office for assistance, mail it, or drop it off during office hours or at a Sunday or Wednesday service. Pledge cards are available on the front pews. Also, feel free to begin giving to the campaign even if you do not submit a pledge card. The official 2-year giving period began May 3.

Glory to God for the widespread participation with 210 pledge cards submitted thus far!
