

# The Lord's Supper

Mark 14:22-24 and 1 Corinthians 11:23-34

October 18, 2020

I. The \_\_\_\_\_

- A. The \_\_\_\_\_ was a focusing on God's deliverance of His people from Egyptian bondage by His power and faithfulness - God would "pass over" the households with the lamb's blood on their doorposts and lintels.

# Instructions for the Lord's Supper



Prepare your hearts anticipating the Lord's Supper this morning during worship. The elements will not be passed around but are located in the pew racks in front and behind you. It is important that you know some specific details about the packaging of the elements in order to avoid distractions.

There are two layers in the packaging, one covering the wafer (plastic) and one covering the juice (foil). When the time comes to partake of the bread, carefully pull only the top, clear layer covering the wafer. The tab may be separated and at an angle (see photo). If you happen to remove both layers at the same time, you may get another container as it would be difficult to proceed without spilling the juice.

When the time comes to partake of the cup, carefully peel off the foil layer. At the conclusion of the service, please take any used containers with you.
